## **COVID 19 Policy for Food Rescue**

For all staff and volunteers in the Food Rescue Transportation Program.

We take the health and safety of our community very seriously and want to remind you of key protocols regarding the pick-up and drop-off of food donations. The guidelines below are to be followed by all volunteers regarding the handling and distribution of food.

Please contact our Food Rescue Dispatcher, 515-207-8908, if you have any questions.

All staff and volunteers must adhere to current CDC guidelines:

- If you or anyone you have been in close contact with in the last 10 days are experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19, please notify the Dispatcher and remain home until tested.
- · Maintain social distancing with others.
- Wash your hands often wit soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer if soap and water are not readily available.
- Frequently clean all surfaces that will touch the food or food packaging and all heavily touched areas and items with an alcohol-based disinfectant.
- Wear a mask during pick up and drop off.

Our food rescue work cannot be done without our volunteers and staff, and it is vitally important to provide safe, healthy working conditions.

Together, we can grow something better for all of us.
